The Palm Beach International Boat Show Gives Back grant program is dedicated to supporting programs that encourage local children's knowledge, access, and appreciation of Florida's ocean and waterways.

This year, the Palm Beach International Boat Show Gives Back program distributed a total of \$500,000 among 25 nonprofit and educational organizations to support waterfront-based projects and educational programs. Overall, the programs stimulate youth interest in marine life, the marine industry, and environmental stewardship. The grants also help support projects and services that enhance the West Palm Beach waterfront.

The grant program is a collaboration between the Marine Industries Association of Palm Beach County (MIAPBC), the owner of the Palm Beach International Boat Show, and Informa, the producer of the show.

The grant program is funded through proceeds from ticket sales, optional ticket price add-ons, and supporters of the Palm Beach International Boat Show. MIAPBC has owned and operated the boat show for more than 40 years. Although the boat show has donated funds to the community for decades, the MIAPBC has committed to enhancing this tradition by taking it to a higher level with the launch of the grant program and application process in 2023. Donations are distributed through the Palm Beach International Boat Show Gives Back fund, managed by the Community Foundation for Palm Beach and Martin Counties.

"As the biggest nautical attraction of the year, the Palm Beach International Boat Show is committed to positively impacting the lives of young people throughout the Palm Beaches and beyond, year-round," said Alyssa Freeman, MIAPBC executive director.



Boat Show Grant Program

Increases Support of

Marine Educational Opportunitiers



Here are just a few examples of community programs that will benefit from the support of the Palm Beach International Boat Show Gives Back program this year.

Inlet Grove Community High School – Cultivating Passion for the Marine Industry

With an eye on future expansion, Inlet Grove Community High School is an A-rated, high-performing charter school for grades nine through 12 in Riviera Beach. It opened its doors in 2003.

Inlet Grove's Maritime Academy is one of nine Career Choice Academies that offer students an academic focus once they've been accepted for admission. Along with fully accredited general coursework that meets all Florida state standards, students earn career certifications and college credits through the academies.

The Palm Beach International Boat Show funding will help expand certifications and programming offered specifically through the Maritime Academy. *"Thanks to this funding, for the first time, students will have the opportunity to earn industry certification through Yamaha, so they can do service checks on either mid-range or in-line outboard engines,"* said Scott McDermott, Inlet Grove's assistant principal and coordinator of career programs.

McDermott notes that Inlet Grove is working with the Palm Beach County School District to build a new facility that will house all the career academies. This will have a positive impact on the number of students it can accept into the Maritime Academy. *"Currently, there are 25 students enrolled in the academy,"* said McDermott. "The goal is to get to 75."

Students can apply to Inlet Grove from all over Palm Beach County. Once students are accepted, they select the academies that most interest them and interview for placement.

McDermott said Inlet Grove is committed to preparing students for college and future careers. For example, to graduate, all students must have a "next step" in place. The next step could be acceptance to a four-year university, community college, or trade school, or enlisting for military service.



"We're looking for kids with a passion for maritime life and the maritime industry," said McDermott. *"We partner with Florida Fishing Academy to get students out on the water as much as possible. We're simply ecstatic and grateful to receive a Palm Beach International Boat Show Gives Back grant. It will help us take things to the next level!"*



Loggerhead Marinelifelife Center – Nurturing Future Marine Biologists

Loggerhead Marinelifelife Center (LMC) has good news for all 6-to-13-year-old aspiring marine biologists. Thanks to a grant from the Palm Beach International Boat Show Gives Back program, the Juno Beach-based nonprofit will offer 20 full-tuition scholarships to its 2024 Junior Marine Biologist seasonal camps. The Center is dedicated to ocean and sea turtle conservation.

"We're committed to making ocean education as equitable as possible," said Hannah Campbell, LMC's vice president of education. *"These scholarships will go a long way, offering great opportunities to kids whose families may be experiencing financial hardship."*

Each weeklong session welcomes about 20 campers. The summer session is June 3 through August 9, and includes three different themes: Conservation Kids, Sea Turtle Savers, and Ocean Adventures.

The seasonal camps are a safe and fun way for kids to remain engaged with their science curriculum during academic breaks. *"We really pump up the science education in each camp, and the kids can't help but have fun while they learn,"* Campbell noted. *"Each camper receives a Junior Marine Biologist camp kit, complete with shirts, swag, and at-home activities to share what they've learned with their family."* Campers learn the basics about environmental science, careers in the field, and perhaps, most importantly, how to be good stewards of the environment.

"We teach kids what they can do to protect marine life, and how to minimize their own human impact on the coastal ecosystems they call home. Overall, they continue learning while connecting with their peers in a safe and fun environment. These are all lessons and memories to last a lifetime."

Florida Fishing Academy – Angling for a Healthy Future

Florida Fishing Academy founder Captain Rich Brochu is using his passion for fishing to teach kids about themselves, their world, and their role in it.

Since 2008, Brochu has taught Palm Beach County Title I elementary and middle school students about fishing as a metaphor for life. Funding from the Palm Beach International Boat Show Gives Back program will help support the Florida Fishing Academy's Angling for a Healthy Future program. During the summer, the Angling for a Healthy Future program consists of classroom instruction, followed by Brochu and his crew taking about 400 children on boat trips out of Riviera Beach.

"Although they live in close proximity to the ocean, 90 percent of these kids have never experienced being out on a boat; they've never tasted salt water," says Brochu. *"We teach them responsible angling and how to bait a hook."*

Brochu says he's grateful for the former students who have kept in touch with him over the years. *"We piqued their interest in the maritime industry. Many became lifeguards to work their way through college,"* he said. *"They tell me we saved their lives."*

Donations Accepted at Time of Ticket Purchase

"We encourage visitors to add donations to their Palm Beach International Boat Show ticket purchases," said Rena Blades, director of community and government affairs for the boat show. *"We hope to double the dollar amount in grants we distribute to help fund many more impactful marine educational opportunities throughout Palm Beach County."*
